In only 1 year, thousands of farmers in Butere-Mumias district, beneficiaries of inputs and advice from FIPS-Africa's network of 45 Village-based Advisors under the USAID-funded KMDP2 Programme, have rapidly multiplied vines of improved sweet potato varieties to become food secure and produce surplus for sale.
